The US has imposed a 50 per cent import duty on Indian goods entering American markets from August 27. It is affecting exports of labourintensive sectors such as shrimp, textiles, leather and

India and the US have been negotiating a bilateral agreement since March. So far, five rounds of negotiations have been completed. For the sixth round, the US team, which was to visit India last month, de-

ferred their visit. While trade relations between the two countries have been strained due to the high tariffs, sources however said things are on track.

In February the two countries announced plans to conclude the first phase of the India-US bilateral trade agreement by fall of 2025.

India and the US are natural partners and teams from both sides are working to conclude negotiations on a bilateral trade deal, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Wednesday in response to President Donald Trump's remarks that efforts are on to address "trade barriers" between the two countries.

The exchange between the two leaders on social media is largely seen as part of efforts by both New Delhi and Washington to reset their ties that witnessed increasing stress in the last few weeks after Trump doubled tariffs on Indian goods.

The US president said he was looking forward to speaking to Modi in the "upcoming weeks" and sounded confident that both sides would be able to seal the proposed trade deal

# Online businesses thrive in J&K as Net connectivity stabilises

Although internet outages in Jammu and Kashmir have sharply declined since 2022, the region has reported a higher number of shutdowns in the first five months of 2025 than in the whole of last year, stated, digital rights group Sflc.in.

From January to May this year, the region recorded 11 shutdowns compared with just two in 2024, according to the Internet Shutdowns Tracker maintained by Sflc.in. Nine of the outages were in Jammu and two in the Valley.

Eight of the nine outages in Jammu were concentrated in the Chenab Valley areas of Doda, Kishtwar and Bhaderwah, areas that have seen sporadic communal tensions and militant violence in recent months.

Official orders cited the risk of the internet being "misused by anti-social elements" to disturb public order and provoke unrest.
